IMPORTANT INFO FOR PARENTS: FZE is required by Federal law to provide a list to military recruiters of our junior and senior students. We will provide students' name, address and phone number. **If you do not want this information given, you must submit a request in writing to your students' school counselor by September 21, 2020.** Additionally, if for any reason you have a problem with a military recruiter or you feel your student is being unduly pursued, please don't hesitate to let us know.

SELECTIVE SERVICE (Males only) DID YOU KNOW? The law requires virtually all male U.S. Citizens and male immigrants residing in the U.S. (permanent resident aliens), to register within 30 days of their 18th birthday. FAFSA: Students planning to attend college in the fall of 2021 are strongly encouraged to file the FAFSA. Students may file their FAFSA application as early as Oct. 1, using their 2019 tax statement.
