



Summer School 2018-19 General Information and Enrollment Packet

- Ft. Zumwalt has partnered with the Springfield Public School District (SPSD) for summer school and will utilize their online program Launch. Teachers will be assigned by the SPSD and these teachers will assign student grades.
- All course work will be completed online. Students will not be required to physically attend but are required to communicate virtually with their instructor.
- Registration will run April 8-June 3. Students should fill out the attached enrollment packet and return to their school counselor.
- Semester 1 will run June 3- June 28, Semester 2 will run July 8-31.
- Students may check out a chromebook from their home school to complete coursework, or they may use their own personal device. If a student uses a district provided chromebook, they must purchase insurance for the device (\$15). Insurance will carry over to the 2019-20 school year.

What coursework is being offered?

- Credit recovery for core coursework in Science, Math, Social Studies and ELA will be offered. Personal Finance and Health will be offered for Credit Attainment.
- Students may earn up to 1 credit and may enroll in either semester. **There will be no extensions. Students must complete coursework by the last day of the semester.**

Grade Reporting

- Students will receive a “Pass” or “Fail” grade for credit recovery courses. Pass/Fail grades are not averaged into a student’s cumulative grade point average. Students taking credit attainment courses will receive the letter grade that they earn through the Launch program.

Frequently Asked Questions

- ❖ **Do Parents/Guardians have access to their student's account?** Yes. If a student is falling behind in his/her coursework, the Launch teacher will be making contact with the parent and student.
- ❖ **Will there be a teacher?** Yes. Each course will be taught by a certified teacher in the state of Missouri. Many of the teachers will be Ft. Zumwalt teachers. Teachers will hold regular office hours (3 hours each day) and are required to respond to student questions and requests in no longer than one business day.
- ❖ **Can I take two courses during the same semester?** Students can take two courses during the same semester. However, students should be cautioned that several hours of work will be required per day. If a student is not prepared to devote a considerable amount of time per day to a course, the student should consider taking one course per semester. Remember, there are no extensions! All course work must be completed by the last day of the semester for which you register.
- ❖ **What if I do not have a device?** The Ft. Zumwalt school district will allow students to check out a device for the summer to complete coursework if you do not have one at home that you can use. Students will be required to purchase a \$15 insurance policy to insure the device against any possible damages. The insurance policy will remain in effect for the whole 2019-20 school year as all of our High School students will receive chromebook devices at the start of the 2019-20 school year.
- ❖ **What if I do not have internet access at home?** If a student needs access to the internet to complete coursework they may work in their home school. Students should contact their building's summer school principal to set up times. Summer school principals are as follows:
 - North High School: Mr. Pohlman
 - South High School: Mr. Serles
 - East High School: Mr. Wright
 - West High School: Dr. Dreyer, Dr. Sutton

- ❖ **I have an IEP or 504 Plan and need special accommodations. How will this work?** The registration paperwork will ask if you have an IEP or 504. This information will be shared with your teacher so that they can make the appropriate accommodations.
- ❖ **After I am enrolled, how will I access my coursework?** Enrollment confirmations are sent to the student's homeschool. The confirmation will include student login and parent observer account information. Your school counselor will have your information.
- ❖ **What kind of technical support is available for a Launch course?** Students have 7 days a week technical support through support@fueledbylaunch.com.
